Dear parent/carer

As you are aware, during Enrichment week the learners in school will have access to the giant inflatable equipment at determined time slots. The hire company has given guidance as to the usage of the equipment in order to keep our learners safe. They will be given the following instructions to ensure that the equipment is used safely. This information will be shared with them and will be sign posted by the equipment.

- Only access the equipment when given permission to do so by supervising staff
- You are not to use the equipment during break or lunchtime
- No food, drinks or gum allowed on or near the inflatable/s to avoid choking or damage.
- Anyone who is responsible for, manning or supervising the inflatables must be over the age of 18
- for insurance purposes.
- All footwear, glasses, jewelry & badges **MUST** be removed before using the inflatable/s.
- No face paint, party poppers, silly string or ink based products to be used either on or near the inflatable/s.
- **IMPORTANT** - Climbing, hanging or sitting on walls is **DANGEROUS** and under no circumstances should be allowed.
- Ensure the inflatable/s are not overcrowded, and limit numbers according to the age and size of occupants using it.
- Please ensure Children are not pushing, colliding, fighting or behaving in a manner likely to injure or cause distress to others.
- Somersaults are strictly forbidden as these are **DANGEROUS**.
- When the inflatable/s is not being used please switch the blower off at the mains.
- Do not allow anyone to bounce on the front safety step as a child could easily bounce off the inflatable/s and get hurt. The step is only there to assist occupants getting on or off the inflatable/s.
- It is advised anyone with a history of back or neck problems avoid use of the inflatable/s.
- Do not allow anyone to be on the inflatable/s during inflation or deflation as this is **DANGEROUS**.
- No pets, toys or sharp instruments to be allowed on or near the inflatable/s.
- Please ensure users are clothed appropriately and all loose items are removed from pockets before use.
- The inflatable/s should not be used if it becomes wet on the jumping area.



Please note that all learners using this inflatable/s do so at their own risk. Should the learner not follow instructions and guidance, and there is an incident or injury, the school is not liable. Our charity will not accept any responsibility for any injury caused to anyone using this equipment. The school is liable for the equipment condition whilst hired, should it become damaged due to learner misuse, the family will jointly be liable for the damage.

We are asking families to confirm that they have read the guidance contained in this letter and have shared this with their child by clicking on the parentpay item. The school will jointly ensure that the learners are informed in school and guidance will be displayed.

I hope that the children have a safe and enjoyable time during their activity week.
